


Seton – genealogical haplotree



SNPs and dating of SNP formation

Each box indicates the SNP or SNPs (in bold) carried by the lines of descent enclosed. The brackets indicate the range of dates within which the SNP was formed. Note that SNPs continue unchanged beyond their formation date.

BY72248 indicates a descent from John Seton, d ca 1434. Not all of his male line descendants will necessarily test positive for this SNP.

FT348446 indicates a descent from William Seton, d 1424. Not all of his male line descendants will necessarily test positive for this SNP.

FT365839 indicates a descent from William Seton of Meldrum, d 1452. Not all of his male line descendants will necessarily test positive for this SNP.

FT211058 indicates a descent from Alexander Seton, 1st Earl of Huntly, d 1470. Not all of his male line descendants will necessarily test positive

The dotted lines around the boxes for SNP FT211058 indicate the uncertainty around which of the Gordon lines, descended from Alexander Seton, 1st Earl of Huntly, the SNP occurred in.
