



## Connecting to eduroam on a Linux laptop

You will first need to configure your laptop in order to connect to eduroam. To do this you will need to download and install a configuration tool. This can be done by connecting to the StrathWifiSetup network available in the Library and Student Residences. The following instructions show the steps for doing so on a Linux laptop. Different versions of Linux may vary slightly in layout but the process will remain the same. You will only need to configure your device once and thereafter it will automatically connect to eduroam.





1. Click on the Network icon.
2. In the pop-up menu that appears, click on StrathWifiSetup.
3. You should see a pop-up message letting you know you are now connected.





4. Open a browser. You should be automatically taken to a page saying "Your connection is not secure". Click on Advanced.




5. Click on Add Exception.




6. Click on Confirm Security Exception.




7. You will automatically go to the StrathWiFiSetup homepage. Scroll down to the instructions for Linux.




8. Click on Install the eduroam installer from eduroam.org.



9. You will automatically go to cat.eduroam.org. Click on eduroam user: download your eduroam installer.



10. In the pop-up box that appears, enter Strathclyde into the Search box.



11. Click on University of Strathclyde.


14. In the pop-up box that appears, click on Save File and OK.



15. Once it has downloaded, click on eduroam-linux-UoS-Eduroam\_2016.sh.




16. Select the text in the file that opens and copy it all.



17. Go to Menu and click on Terminal.







24. Click on OK.
