



## Map a Drive

You can map your H: Drive or i: Drive on your Windows computer while on campus or connected through VPN.




1. In the This PC folder, click on the Options icon.

2. In the drop-down menu, click on Map network drive.



3. In the window that appears, where it says Drive:, click on the drop-down button.

4. From the drop down menu, select H: or I:.




5. To connect to your i: Drive, where it says Folder, enter <\\ds.strath.ac.uk\idrive>

6. In the pop-up box that appears, click on More choices.

To connect to your H: Drive, where it says Folder, enter \\ds.strath.ac.uk\home\ then your username. For example, <\\ds.strath.ac.uk\hdrive\home\pkb09111>

Click on Finish.


