




Connecting your iPhone or iPad to eduroam for the first time

These instructions are for connecting your iPhone or iPad to the eduroam wifi for the first time. This can be done by connecting to the StrathWifiSetup network available in the Library and Student Residences. Once you configure your device to connect to eduroam, you will connect automatically afterwards. By configuring your device, you will not only be able to ensure your iPhone/iPad connects to eduroam here at Strathclyde, but this will ensure your device will be configured to connect to eduroam on any campus you travel to.

3. Select StrathWifiSetup.





5. In the pop-up box that appears, enter Strathclyde in the search box.




6. When it appears, select University of Strathclyde.



7. Select Download your eduroam installer.




8. Your download will begin.




9. In the pop-up box that appears, select Install.


If this window doesn't immediately pop up, please check Settings and select Profile Downloaded.




10. Enter your device's passcode if you are asked for it.



11. Select Install.




12. In the pop-up box that appears, select Install.




13. Enter your username followed by @strath.ac.uk, for example pkb09111@strath.ac.uk. Select Next.

15. Select Done.




17. Select the Wi-Fi tab.




18. Next to StrathWifiSetup, select the Information icon.
