Read&Write GOLD Site Licence Agreement

Licence Terms

The site licence permits the installation of **Read&Write GOLD** on each PC and university owned laptop held within the University of Strathclyde main campus and each surrounding building to a radius of 2 miles.

The satellite licence permits the installation of **Read&Write GOLD** on all PCs and university owned laptops within a building that lies more than 2 miles away from the main campus building.

The licence allows both contracted staff and registered students to run the software on campus.

Off Campus

The software is for use on University owned PCs only.

Under the University's licence agreement, users of this software have no entitlement to either download, install or run Read&Write on their personal equipment but are allowed to use the software off-campus if the PC or laptop belongs to the University.

Personal Copies

.All registered students can access this software on any centrally managed lab PCs. Departments have the right to install it within their own labs if requested.
