Ethical Investment:

Strathclyde will implement a Sustainable Ethical Investment Policy



- A University Sustainable Ethical Investment Policy will be implemented by **September 2025**. The policy proposed will focus on responsible investing in companies whose aims align with the University's Social and Environmental Sustainability Strategy. The policy should include expectations for the positive and active use of investment in support of the transition to a low carbon economy, consistent with the need to be prudent in seeking an appropriate financial return.
- The policy has a clear reporting and review cycle, with reporting being made available in formats accessible to all members of the Strathclyde community.

Education for sustainable development:

All students at Strathclyde develop an understanding of sustainability through their course and the impact they can have that is specific to their industry through their degree.



- Work to integrate ESD is continued, with student engagement at all levels as part of the curriculum review.
- Students get both introductory sustainability education as well as degree specific education integrate into their modules.
- Active citizenship is encouraged, such as the implementation of the sustainability passport.
